



## LIFEBOAT DRILL - SUNDAY 5 APRIL 1998 10:15 am.


Abandon ship alarm will not be sounded.

10:15 am : Abandon ship drill.

All hands except personell on watch, muster in accordance with instructions on Emergency Plan.

When accounted for at stations, all muster at stb. lifeboat station for full lifeboat drill.

Chief Officer.



#### GENERAL EMERGENCY INSTRUCTION.

Master on Bridge in overall command. Keeps in contact with all squads.

Ch. Off / Ch. Eng. at scene of incident. Ch. Off, to direct operations on deck or in accomposition. Ch. Eng. to direct operations in machinery spaces.

#### GENERAL FIRE INSTRUCTION

Activate alarm signal on detection of fires, no matter how small the fire seems to be. Try to extinguish a starting fire with extinguishers, blankets etc. If not possible to put out the fire in it's first minute, close all ventilation to prevent air reaching the place of fire.

Do not open doors or hatches from areas where smoke is seen to be coming out, unless wearing fire-protection equipment and carrying fire extinguishing equipment.

Keep in mind that a smouldering fire may produce invisible toxic gas.

When alarm sounds, proceed immediately to muster station. Rapid response is vital in all cases including drifts

REPORT IF ANY PERSON IS MISSING Iffin port raise alarm and call for assistance by V-F. Ships Whistle, phone or any other means.

It is the duty of every crew member to be familiar with the location and use of all fine fighting equipment, procedures and emergency drifts.

#### OTHER EMERGENCIES

Raise the alarm and proceed to muster station or as informed on vessel's communication system. Pollow orders and routines as practised during drills and as per Contingency Manual Guidelines and SOPEP.







